Tour Points of Interest

Nolin River Dam to Houchins Ferry-This trip begins in the tail-waters of Nolin Lake. The launch site is at the foot of the very beautiful Dismal Rock. A picturesque canopy of trees will keep you shaded through most of this trip as it once did when steam boats transported asphalt in the early 1900's. The entire trip is abundantly laden with many forms of wild plant and animal life. As you enter Green River at the mouth of Nolin, turn left and paddle up stream about 1.5 miles to Houchins Ferry where your trip ends. This trip is often used by the Geology instructors at Western Kentucky University for field trips for their students because of its unique geological formations. **9:30am-2pm**

Lost River Cave's Underground Boat Tour - is the only of its kind in Kentucky. The guided tour includes a lovely historic river walk which leads you to one of the largest cave entrances east of the Mississippi River. Visitors embark on a journey into the world that exists beneath the city of Bowling Green. Daylight disappears as you board the boat on the river that **Ripley's Believe It or Not** claims is the shortest & deepest in the world. Prehistoric Native Americans, thousands of **Civil War** troops, **Col. John Hunt Morgan** and even the notorious Jesse James are said to be among the cave's legendary visitors. Stroll along the historic river walk and visit the site of the famous 1930s Underground Nite Club. Rediscover the child inside when you cross the threshold into the captivating seasonal Butterfly Habitat. **3pm-4pm**

Lost River Mining-Don't let the Fool's Gold fool you!-The rock and mineral sluice is fun for kids from ages 1 to 100. Everyone will have a sluice bag and pan for gemstones. To help you identify your treasures, you will receive a postcard with an identification key. You keep everything you find in your bag including crystals, rose quartz, amethyst, even emeralds and rubies. **4pm-5pm**

Overnight Tent Camping - Everyone will have a new sleeping bag and flashlight to keep!

Jesse James Riding Stables-There is nothing more exciting than horseback riding at the Jesse James Riding Stables, one of the largest riding stables in Kentucky. In business for over 34 years, the stables offer an outstanding experience. Their guides lead you into the valley to see some of the most breathtaking scenery this area has to offer. **10:30am-11:30am**

Outlaw Cave- offers a 45-minute non-strenuous guided tour filled with beautiful stalactites, stalagmites and other breathtaking formations. **1pm-2pm**

After a cool relaxing cave tour you will have 3 hours to enjoy as many activities as you like. Alpine Slide- the only alpine slide in Kentucky, you will begin by taking the scenic chairlift ride to the top of the mountain. Get in your sled and you begin the 1/4 mile trip down the mountain filled with turns and bends that are sure to give you a thrill! A unique control lever allows each rider to control the speed down the mountain. **Bumper Cars**- enjoy the thrill of being able to legally run your car into your neighbor, but beware the bumper cars can be addictive. Bumper cars are enjoyable for all ages. **Mini Golf, Bumper Boats, Go Carts and Rock Wall Climbing. 2pm-5pm**
